#### Recent Renovation

On the heels of a recent multi-million dollar renovation completed in 2018, The Point continues to pay homage to its Great Camp heritage by bringing this beautiful estate to a new level of luxury and rustic elegance. This is the first major renovation following the purchase of The Point in June 2016 by long-time regulars, Laurie and Pierre Lapeyre. In addition, the renovation provided attention to the common spaces including The Pub, plus the winterization of The Boathouse, making this most requested room available for year-round booking. The Great Hall shines brightly with luxuriant new fabrics, drapery, furniture and lighting setting the stage for the tradition of elegant social dining where guests gather as the high society of the Gilded Age once did at vibrant house parties deep in the forest.

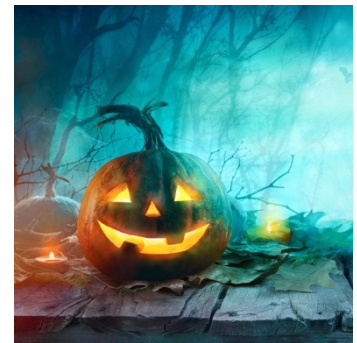
**Stave Puzzles – Annual Puzzle Madness at The Point**

The Point is an intimate and exclusive 11-room, year-round, adults-only, inclusive Adirondack estate situated on a secluded 75-acre peninsula stretching into Upper Saranac Lake in Saranac Lake, NY. A Great Camp of the Great North Woods, The Point was built by William Avery Rockefeller II as his family’s private retreat in the early 1930s. The Point is a member of Relais & Châteaux (designated as the first Relais & Châteaux property in North America in 1983), has consistently received the coveted *Forbes* Five-Star designation for 20 consecutive years (awarded annually from 1999 - present and is the only *Forbes* Five-Star property in New York State located outside of New York City.
