THE POINT RESORT is located in Upper Saranac Lake in New York. The first Relais and Châteaux hotel in North America, The Point is a private, lakefront, Adirondack estate that was originally built as a Great Camp for William Avery Rockefeller II from 1930-1933. A fanciful log mansion retreat full of priceless art and fine antiques, The Point personifies the 19th Century romantic notion

of “roughing it” in great comfort, style and luxury. Its all-inclusive nature allows for carefree days; the body and mind can take well deserved time to refresh in a forested environment totally conducive to enjoying life’s pleasures.

The intimate, yet spacious location of the property is the perfect setting for couples to connect on their honeymoon without distraction as there are no TVs and little Wi-Fi. Guests receive access to all 75-acres of the secluded property and the staff anticipate guests’ every need. From organizing bespoke dining experiences like a picnic on the lake’s edge curated with seasonal bites to a champagne toast from The Point’s ELCO Boat, a glass enclosed electric boat used for leisurely rides, the dedicated staff is on hand to make any honeymoon special. Couples can spend their days partaking in a variety of outdoor activities like kayaking along the lake while taking in the view of the High Peaks or hiking to Camp David, a cabin serving fireside cocktails for those breezy summer evenings.
