There's a growing number of upscale hotels where **furry friends** are welcomed as family members and treated like pet royalty. Brands like Kimpton Hotels and **Virgin Hotels** have become trailblazers in pet-friendly luxury travel, adopting straightforward, all-welcome, no-fee policies. Other trusted brands and independent properties have also jumped on the pet-friendly bandwagon, but typically with some terms, conditions, and fees worth noting.

As more hotels cater to four-legged guests, there's newfound competition as each tries to outshine the next with Instagram-worthy amenities, special pet-dining menus, "yappy hours," and adorable canine ambassadors. The Point Resort

The Point Resort, Upper Saranac Lake, New York

Go back in time to the Great Camp era of the late 19th century at [William Avery Rockefeller's former private estate](#), reinvented as an adults-only, dog-friendly, 11-room luxury lodge of Relais and Châteaux pedigree. Dogs can participate in most activities of the all-inclusive vacation experience, including bonfire lunches, lakeside cocktails, late nights in The Pub, hikes throughout the 75-acre estate, and boating across Upper Saranac Lake (The Point even provides pet life vests). They'll get their own specially cooked meals and treats courtesy of the lodge's all-star culinary team and retreat nightly to cuddles and belly rubs by the fireplace—each room has one.
