The Point, Saranac Lake, New York

In the latter half of the nineteenth century, affluent families built cabin compounds on lakes in the Adirondacks. These came to be known as Adirondack Great Camps.



At [The Point](#), the Relais & Chateaux great camp property still features a 1,200 square-foot room boathouse, with a wraparound deck looking out onto peaceful Saranac Lake. Inside, there is a high-vaulted ceiling, a stone fireplace, and a large canopied bed. The large deck also features two hanging twin beds which are ideal for post-boat ride naps or a quiet night's rest. The hotel recommends calling about six months in advance to reserve.
