

THE POINT, NEW YORK



Holding the distinction of the first Relais and Châteaux hotel in North America, this private, lakefront Adirondack escape was constructed as a camp for William Avery Rockefeller II in the 1930s. Now, The Point has 11 unique rooms spread across four original log buildings, giving guests a sense of “roughing it,” albeit in extreme style. The all-inclusive approach means that visitors can genuinely have a carefree stay, enjoying help-yourself beverages spread throughout the property, caviar tastings, boating and fishing activities, and seven-course black-tie dinners held on Wednesday and Saturday nights.
