Today, [The Point Resort](#) is the only Forbes Five Star resort in Upstate New York as well as the first Relais & Châteaux member of North America.

There are just eleven rooms available, and guests are encouraged to take full advantage of the venue's lush surroundings and elegant traditions, including dressing up for the evening dinner service. Best yet, patrons pay a single rate in advance of their arrival, so all that's left to do is show up and enjoy.
